# State vs Local Positives

Locally we are only counting lab confirmed PCR positive tests of patients with local address as their permanent residence.

Contact tracing is happening for:

- ▶ Positives
- ▶ Non-residents
- ▶ Presumptive Positives
- ▶ Probable Positives

At the State level, they are counting positives, presumptive positives, indeterminates, all individuals with symptoms in an outbreak.

# Update on Indicators

How is our standing in the Blue level?

We have gotten 10 positive test results in today.

4%	>40% of the 24-licensed beds filled at GVH with patients having COVID-19 illness
2.60%	GVH employees out with respiratory illness is 7 to 15%
FALSE	PPE supply is >28 days but restock sources cannot fulfill orders.
