Protect Our Neighbors

- Highest level of the State's new Public Health Dial
- The State's Dial is a color-coded system like our Coronameter
- Currently five Colorado Counties in PON
- Not a permanent designation
 - If fall out of compliance with PON, State will monitor for three weeks and coordinate with local public health department after that

PON Metrics

- The State's Dial system has specific criteria to determine position (Protect Our Neighbors, Safer At Home 1-3, Stay At Home)
- State continues to monitor these metrics for PON counties
 1. New Cases
 - a. Cases are different than positive tests
 - b. Roughly 4 new cases in two-week period
 2. Percent Positivity of Testing
 - a. Must remain below 5% positivity in testing in two-week averages
 3. Stable or Declining Hospitalizations

mean for
everybody?

Gunnison County remains committed to The Seven Commitments of Containment

1. Physical Distancing
2. Face Covering
3. Screening, Isolation, or Quarantine
4. Enhanced Hand Hygiene
5. Enhanced Cleaning/Disinfecting
6. Protecting the at Risk Community
7. Enhanced Ventilation

What does it mean for Business?

- We have proven to the State that our local measures are working, which allows us to continue following them
- Gunnison County continues to operate in the Blue Level of the Coronameter
 - Businesses should continue to follow the Blue Level guidance and the particulars of the sector plan associated with the establishment
- Any future changes/adjustments will be announced by Gunnison County Public Health

What has changed across business sectors?

- Group Sizes increase
 - Group sizes of 50 Indoors/250 Outdoors
- Event Sizes increase
 - Indoor events up to 50 Indoors/250 Outdoors
 - Potential for larger events but must be approved by Public Health Director and Law Enforcement through the ERMA process
 - Events must continue to use the [Event Risk Mitigation Application](#) process
- Potential to increase occupancy limitations
 - Every four weeks we maintain PON status we have the opportunity to consider increasing occupancy by 5%
- Updates to the Bars/Restaurant Sector Plan coming
