Additional Business Updates & Resources

Energize CO GAP Fund

Currently the GAP Fund is on its Round Two application cycle. **Applications accepted on a rolling basis through October 26th for Round Two.** By many accounts it sounds like the GAP Fund has had a high volume of requests and the application communication can be delayed. We encourage you to apply well in advance of the 10/26/20 deadline should you be interested. More info at [Energize Colorado](#).

Small businesses with fewer than 25 full-time employees can apply for support through a mixture of grants and loans, up to a maximum of \$15,000 in grants and \$20,000 in loans for a possible combined total of \$35,000 in financial assistance.

Greenline Emergency Microloan Program

Greenline Ventures seeks to provide funding to small businesses throughout the Western Slope of Colorado to help deal with adverse impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Businesses must be in the Western Slope of Colorado (with an emphasis for businesses based in Grand Junction) and have fewer than 50 employees. Must be able to show adverse impact from the pandemic. The Microloan Program provides loans on the following terms:

Loan Amount: Loans are available for \$10,000 up to \$50,000 **Interest / Amortization:** No interest or principal payments for the first six months, followed by 54 months of level principal and interest payments at a 2% interest rate **Maturity:** 60 months / 5 years **Fees:** There are no fees (application, origination, exit) or prepayment penalties **Collateral:** No collateral requirements.

Public Health Updates

Gunnison County had a remarkable turn out for the flu clinic. 713 people got their flu shot in Gunnison and 582 in Crested Butte. In a total of 7 hours, 1,295 people received their flu vaccine. A reminder that flu vaccine is also available at City Market and Wal-Mart.

In the 14-day period from Sep. 25 – Oct. 9, positivity sits at 1.25% with a total of 4 positive results. We do not meet any of the [indicators](#) for a move to yellow (three of seven criteria must be met).

Overall, we have seen 262 positive tests so far with 3,052 negative tests.
