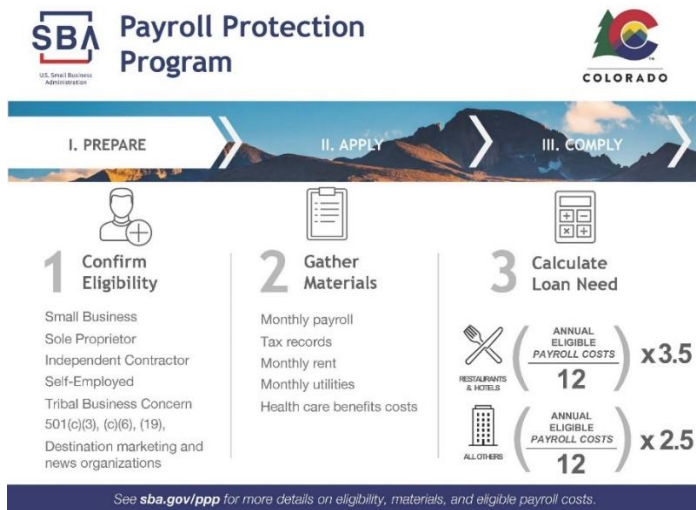

Public Health Updates

Our numbers are at 948 positive, 9,472 negative, and 107 pending tests as of January 14th.

We continue to meet two indicators for a move to yellow. Our positive cases and our positivity continue to be well above our Coronameter thresholds. While positive cases are at a high level in our community, our ability to give care is still in a good place so we remain in our local [blue level restrictions](#).

We will try to provide an update on the community testing results from 1/15 & 1/16 if we have them available.
