Public Health Updates

As of 12/31 there have been 69 positive tests in the last 10 days. There are 74 pending tests as of this writing. We continue to see 40 or more positive tests per week.

The community-wide, mass testing event yielded a positivity rate of 2.7% within the sample. We can all make a difference in containing the spread.
