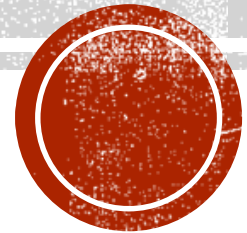

# PPP UPDATE AS OF 2/22/21

- **The Biden Administration is implementing the following changes to PPP:**
- **Instituting a special 14-day application period, starting this Wednesday (2/24/21), during which only businesses with fewer than 20 employees can apply for PPP.**
  - PPP 2.0 program applications expire on 3/31/21
- Revising and amending the PPP loan calculation formula for sole-proprietors, independent contractors and self-employed applicants to ensure they receive more relief, and establish a \$1 billion set aside for businesses in this category without employees, located in low to moderate-income areas.
- Expanding PPP eligibility to small business owners with prior non-fraud felony convictions who were previously ineligible to apply.
- Allowing firm owners who are delinquent on their federal student loans to apply for PPP.
- Expanding PPP eligibility to non-citizen small business owners who are lawful U.S. residents by clarifying that they may use Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs) to apply for relief.



# COVID-19 TESTING UPDATES

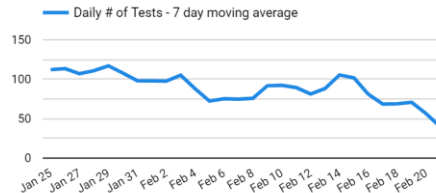
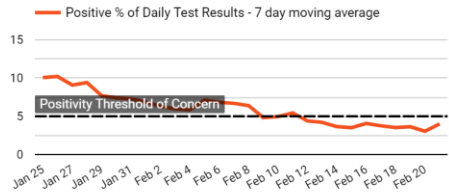
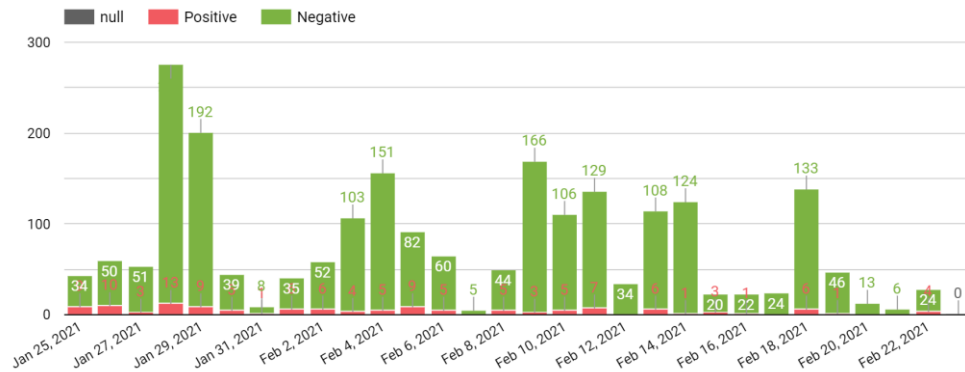
- Free testing for anyone for any reason is now available through Gunnison Valley Health
- Asymptomatic testing will be on a first come first serve basis by appointment
- You may not receive an appointment on the day you request
- To make an appointment, reach out to the Call Center at 970-641-7660
- Community testing events through CDPHE will occur on:
  - Friday, March 26<sup>th</sup> at the Gunnison County Fairgrounds, 7:00 am – 5:00 pm
  - Saturday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at the Crested Butte Community School, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm



# DASHBOARD UPDATES

Swab and Rapid Test Data (prior 30-days, updated Sun/Wed evenings)

*Thus, results for a day may change as new results are received.*



- Dashboard is now pulling single-stream of data
  - Manual updates occurring Sunday and Wednesday evening. Early March daily updates will resume
- Adjusted to date of result for positives (like the State) since result times have generally improved.
  - This means pending tests no longer display
- Positivity and # of Tests data is also now on a 7-day cycle. Again for consistency with State data



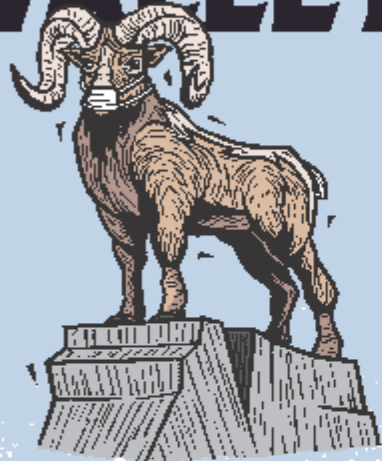
# PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE

- As of 2/22/21, Gunnison County has maintained 5 days of 'Blue' indicators on the state Dial
- With seven-consecutive days of those metrics aligned Gunnison County will be able to request CDPHE to move us to 'Blue' on the Dial
- Gunnison County continues to be Blue on the Coronameter
- With the results currently available, we are meeting 0-7 indicators for Yellow
  - We do have outstanding tests from last week that had been shipped to labs in Texas
- Gunnison County has administered 6,191 total doses of vaccine. Of this total, 2,162 are fully vaccinated.
  - We intend to deliver over 500 first doses and 800 second doses this week
  - City Market also has a vaccine [scheduling system](#) for the doses they receive from the Feds
