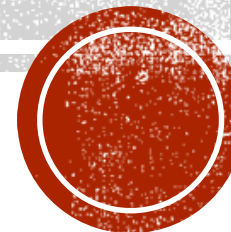

GOVERNOR'S MASK MANDATE

- Over the weekend the Executive Order for Facial Coverings was updated and extended
- Despite common perception, it still requires facial coverings in ALL counties in the following locations
 - Schools, state government facilities, prisons/jails, congregate living facilities, personal services, and most healthcare settings.
- Counties with an incidence rate less than 35 per 100,000 can modify masking requirements outside those categories
- Gunnison County continues to have a facial covering requirement in the PHO. Should be worn indoors or outdoors if social distance cannot be maintained.

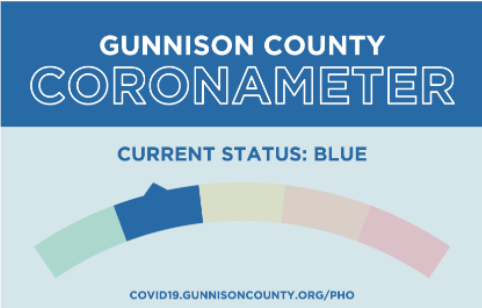


PHASE 2 VACCINATIONS ARE OPEN

- Gunnison County is now scheduling appointments for Phase 2 vaccination
- Phase 2 = General Public
- Adults over 16 are eligible to receive vaccination
 - Pfizer is the only vaccine currently approved for 16-18 year olds
- Gunnison County routinely receives Pfizer doses and we will continue to schedule this population in the clinics where Pfizer is available
- Continue utilizing the [Vaccine Interest Form](#) to get scheduled for vaccination
- CDPHE also has a mass vaccination site at the Grand Junction Convention Center
 - This is open to all CO residents Monday-Friday from 9am-4pm

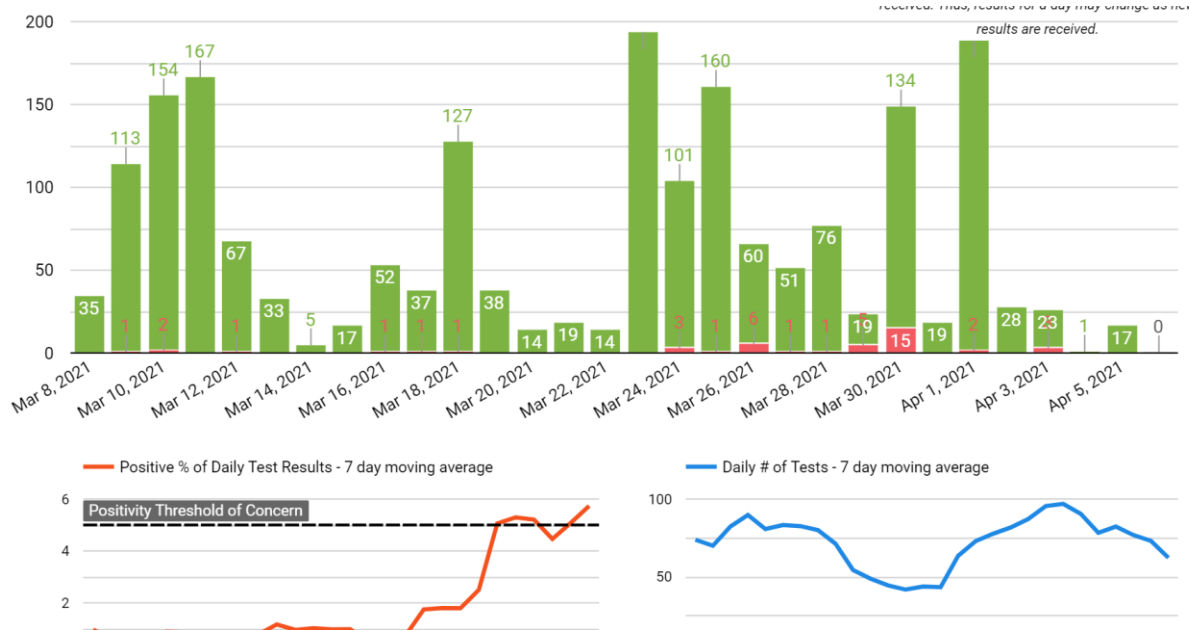


Vaccination Data (cumulative, update on Mondays)

PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE NUMBERS



- 20+ positive results in the last 7-days
- Dashboard not updated daily yet
- Many positives associated with travel and exposure outside of people's normal routines
- Testing continues to be available for 'personal reasons' through GVH
- Widespread testing helps show the actual prevalence in our community
 - Starting 4/14 all testing will be scheduled M-F from 9am-12pm
