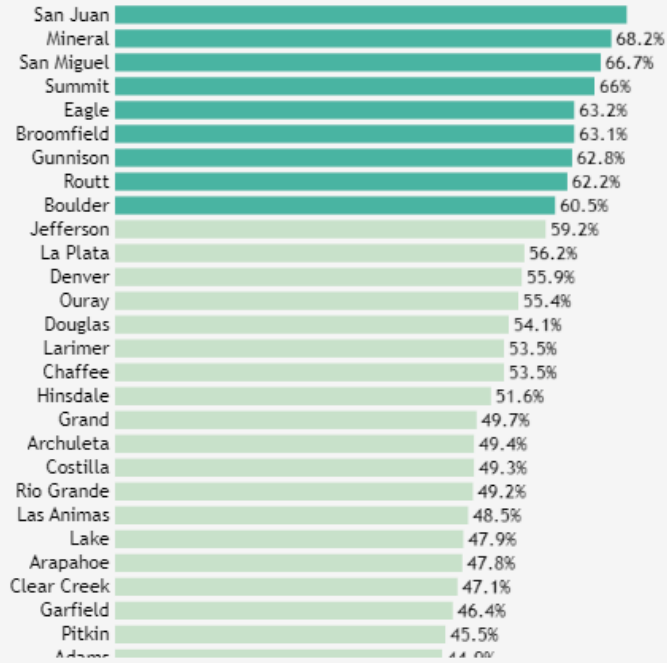
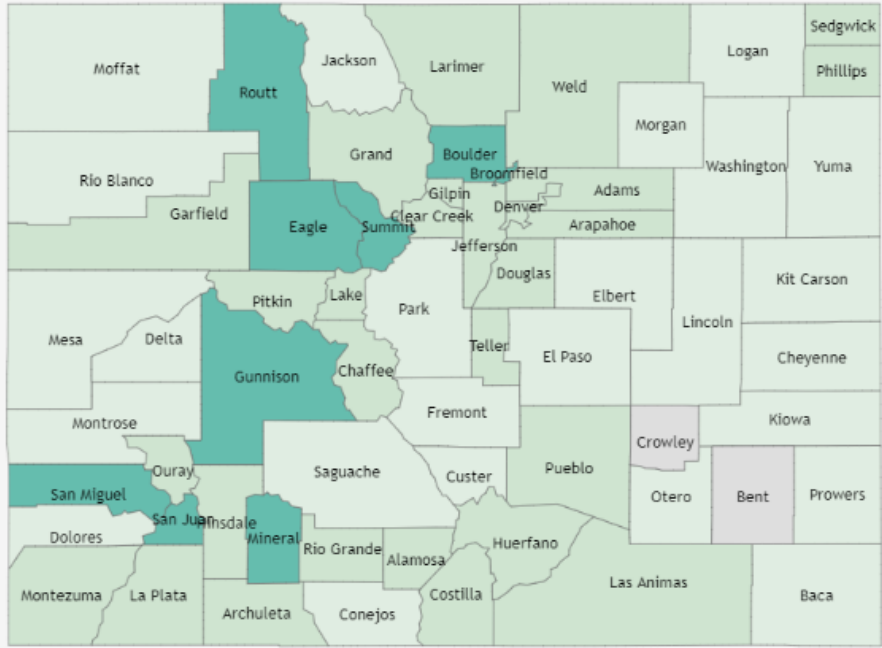
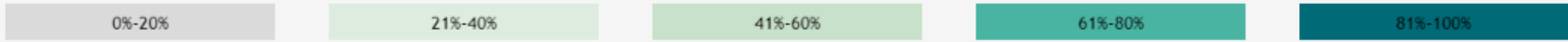

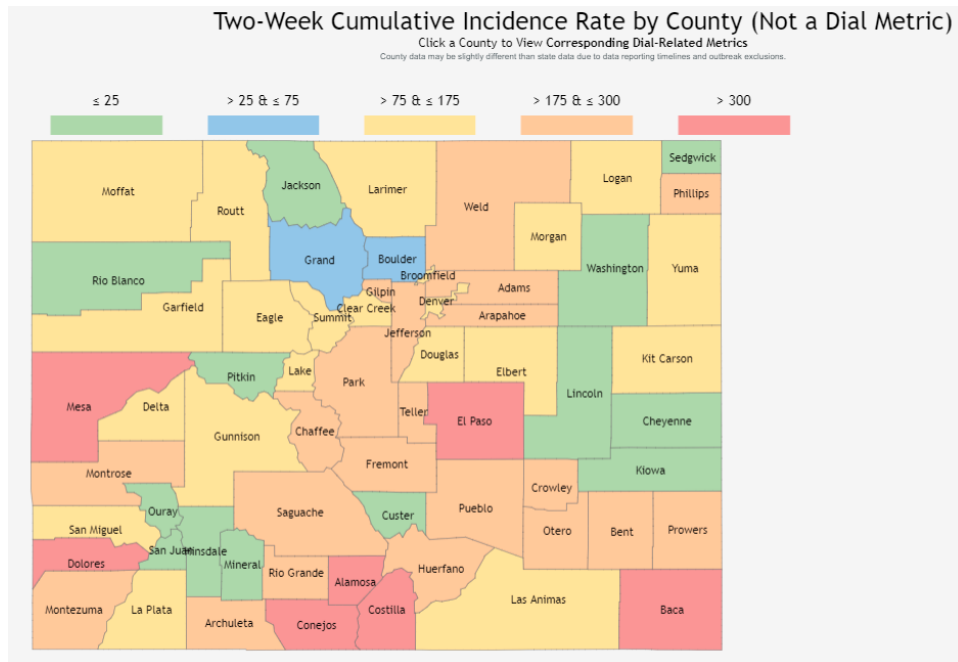
# Vaccination Rates in Colorado

# Statewide Cases and Variant Growth



- ▶ Not all of our Western Slope neighbors have seen the same success in vaccination
- ▶ There is significant and increasing Coronavirus variant presence throughout the Western Slope
- ▶ Your risk in Gunnison County is not the same as neighboring communities
- ▶ Be smart, be safe

# Gunnison County Goes Green!

- ▶ Due to our high vaccination rate and increased availability of vaccine to residents (including ages 12+), Gunnison County will transition to Green on the Coronameter on 5/28/21
- ▶ We expect to hit our 10,000 goal very shortly as second-doses continue to cycle through our clinics
  - ▶ As of 5/24:
    - ▶ 9,681 Gunnison County residents are fully vaccinated
      - ▶ By week's end we expect to have exceeded 97% of our fully vaccinated target
    - ▶ 62.81% of residents eligible (12+) for vaccine are fully vaccinated
- ▶ Community protection is high in Gunnison County

# What does Green mean for you?

- ▶ Outside of a few exceptions, there are no indoor facial covering requirements in Gunnison County
  - ▶ Facial covering requirements continue in the following settings consistent with Federal guidance
    - ▶ Healthcare
    - ▶ Public Transportation (busses, airports, planes, etc.)
    - ▶ Jails/Prisons
    - ▶ Schools and Childcare
    - ▶ Any other business or setting requiring facial coverings
- ▶ Non-vaccinated folks are highly encouraged to continue utilizing a facial covering

# What does Green mean for business?

- ▶ Social distancing, capacity limits, and event size restrictions are no longer required
- ▶ Businesses may operate under their pre-pandemic practices
- ▶ Gunnison County businesses may continue public health restrictions as a best practice
  - ▶ We ask that you respect the will of any business that continues public health guidance in their establishment
