COVID-19 MODIFIED RISK LEVEL DECLARATION

I, Joni Reynolds, Gunnison County Public Health Director, pursuant to the laws of the State of Colorado and the Tenth Amended Public Health Order (issued June 8, 2020) (Order), hereby declare the current COVID-19 risk level is Risk Level **GREEN** with the modifications set forth in this Declaration.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Paragraph II(A)(3)(c) of the Tenth Amended Standing Public Health Order (entered June 8, 2020, as renewed by the Eleventh Amended Standing Public Health Order (entered December 28, 2020)) (“PHO”), the restrictions imposed by foregoing risk level are modified as follows: There are no restrictions on Events, and persons and businesses within Gunnison County may engage in normal operations and activities, except a modified version of the Face Covering Requirements, as set forth on page 7 of the PHO, shall continue to apply as follows: All persons (regardless of vaccination status) are required to wear a Face Covering in all 1) indoor health care settings (*e.g.*, hospitals, doctor’s offices); 2) public school buildings and indoor facilities; 3) child care centers; 4) public transportation vehicles and indoor facilities (*e.g.*, buses, the Gunnison County Airport); 5) detention facilities (*e.g.*, the Gunnison County Jail); and 6) courtrooms and court facilities (*e.g.* the Gunnison County District Courtroom).

In all other indoor and outdoor locations, Face Coverings are no longer required. Private businesses and Federal, state and local governments may continue to require customers, patrons, employees or members of the public to use Face Coverings while inside any business or in any indoor or outdoor location.

It is recommended that all individuals not vaccinated should continue to wear a Face Covering in both indoor and outdoor settings.

I make this Declaration based upon both current public health needs within Gunnison County and the Interim Public Health Recommendations for Fully Vaccinated People issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention on May 13, 2021, as well as the face covering provisions set forth in Executive Order D 2021 103 (issued May 14, 2021).
