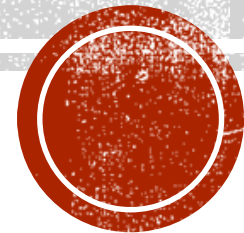

RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION FUND

- Application opened yesterday (5/4/21)
- Important to apply ASAP if you have not already applied
 - \$28.6 Billion available but expected to go very fast
- Application
- Info, Eligibility and necessary documents
- Questions or assistance with your application at 1-844-279-8898
 - Open from 8am-8pm Eastern
- Priority Application Period: SBA will fund applications where the applicant has self-certified that it meets the eligibility requirements for a small business owned by women, veterans, or socially and economically disadvantaged individuals.
- Also considering 'set asides' for those with revenue under \$500,000 or between \$500k-\$1.5 million



COLORADO MEETING AND EVENTS INCENTIVE PROGRAM

- HB21-1263
 - Bill is currently 're-engrossed' by the legislature
 - 3rd of 6 steps in passing the bill
- Will be managed by the Colorado Tourism Office
- Intended to attract or retain 'qualifying events' in communities
 - Provides 10% subsidy on hard costs and up to 25% reimbursement on COVID safety measures
- Must take place between 7/1/21 and 12/31/2022
- Conditions for qualifying established by CTO
 - But, must generate at least 25 paid overnights stays in local lodging

SALES TAX RETAINER FOR QUALIFYING SECTORS

- HB21-1265
 - Bill has been introduced and is under consideration
- ‘A qualifying retailer in the alcoholic beverages drinking 9 places industry, or in the restaurant and other eating places industry, OR 10 IN THE FOOD SERVICES CONTRACTOR INDUSTRY may deduct from state net 11 taxable sales the lesser of state net taxable sales or seventy thousand 12 dollars and retain the resulting sales tax collected for each month in the 13 specified sales tax period.’
- Catering industry has been added to bill language
- June, July, and August allows you to deduct up to \$70,000 in State Sales Tax

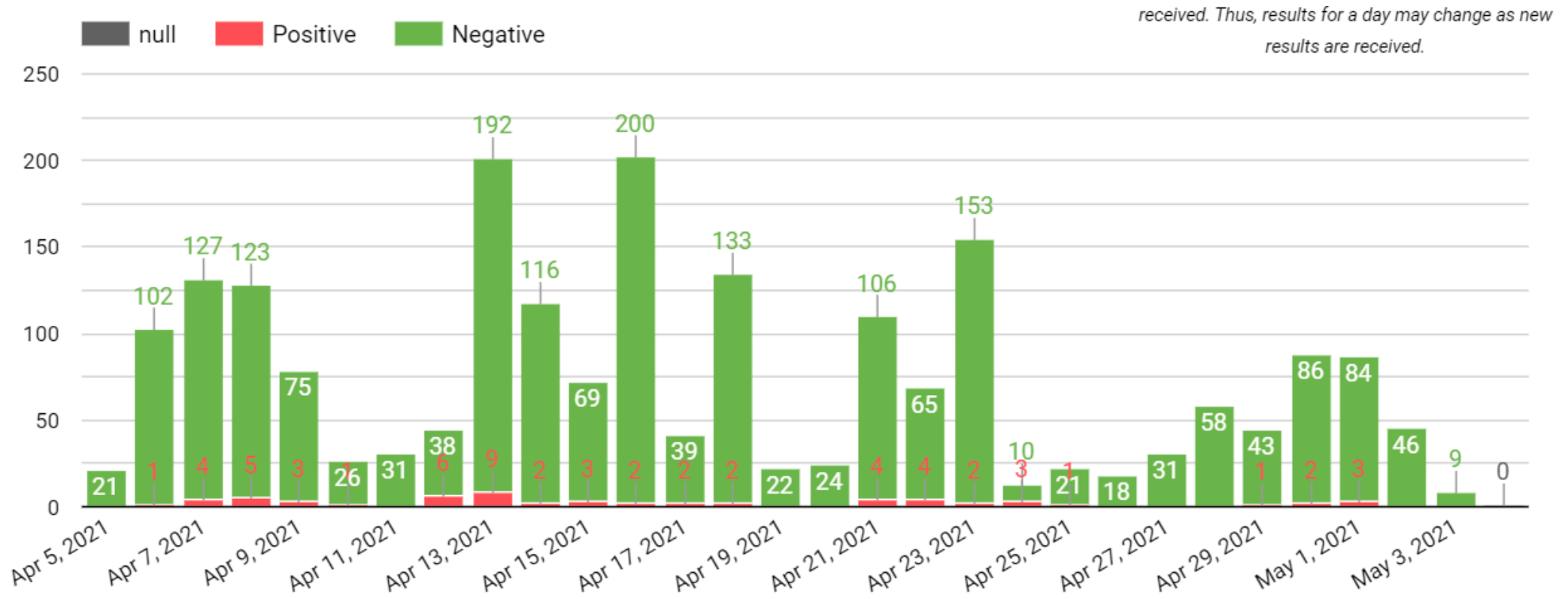


SMALL BUSINESS ACCELERATED GROWTH PROGRAM

- SB21-241
- Introduced and under consideration
- Run through office of Economic Development
- Business development support to entities
 - "BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT" MEANS THE PERFORMANCE OF STRATEGIC SMALL BUSINESS HIGH-GROWTH PROGRAMS THAT ASSIST WITH MARKETING, OPERATIONS AND FINANCE, ACCESS TO CAPITAL, EXPORTING, SEARCH ENGINE OPTIMIZATION, AND OTHER PROGRAMS TO BE -2- SB21-241 1 IDENTIFIED BY THE OFFICE."
- Must have 19 or less employees and meet other conditions like being in an 'Enterprise Zone' or 'Rural Jump-Start Zone'
- Support businesses moving from 'start-up' to more stable footing through SBDC and other regional resources
