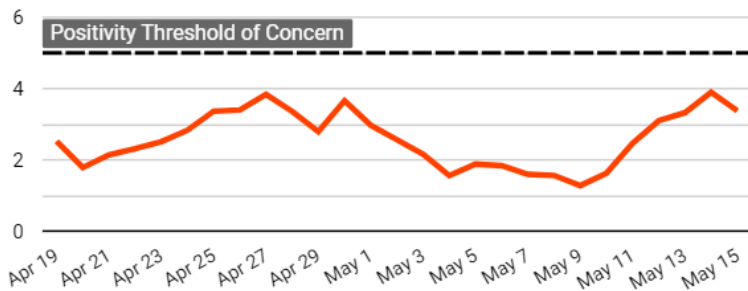

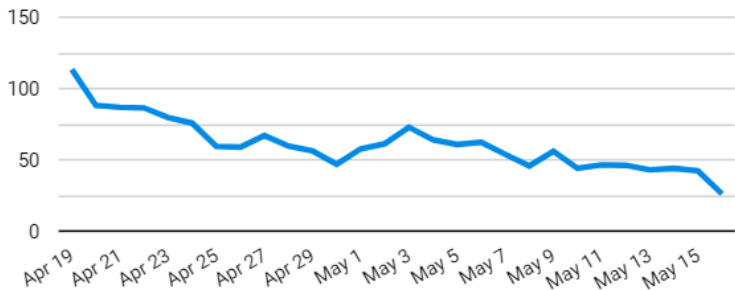
LOCAL NUMBERS

- More than 70% of 16+ population has received a first dose
- We have nearly 9,300 fully vaccinated
- Several hundred are overdue for a second dose
 - Reminding folks they can walk-in to complete their vaccination cycle
 - May not have received a scheduling notification



WORKPLACE & WORKSITE VACCINATION

- Recognizing that not all populations who haven't received vaccination are hesitant or uncertain
 - Unique socio-economic constraints can be limiting
- Gunnison County will come vaccinate at the workplace
 - Date and time will be coordinated with you ahead of time
 - Can be a two-shot or one-shot sequence

PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER UPDATE

- Modified Blue Level in place as of 5/17/21
 - No outdoor masks required



TRANSITION TO GREEN

1. Pace of vaccination – closing on the 10,000 target
 2. Increased access to vaccination with expansion of Pfizer EUA
 - a. More of the population eligible to be vaccinated
- We anticipate being able to shift to Green on the Coronameter on 5/28/21
 - This means no additional public health restrictions
 - No capacity limits, no event reviews, and no indoor masks outside of very limited settings consistent with Federal guidance (Healthcare, Public Transportation, Schools, Jails/Prisons)
 - Public Health Order will sunset entirely on 7/1/21
 - We want you to be able to plan your staffing, materials, and other needs appropriately for the transition to Green
