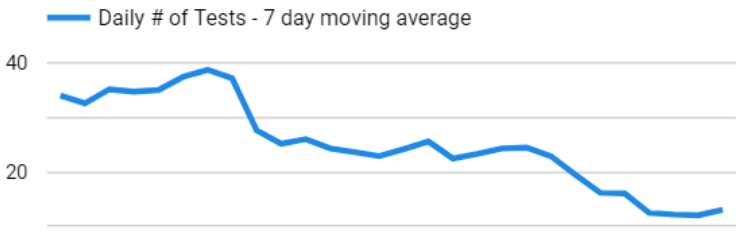
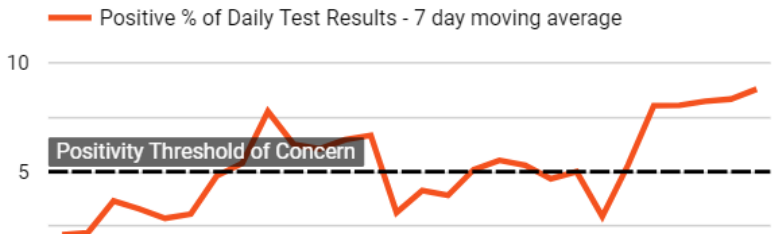
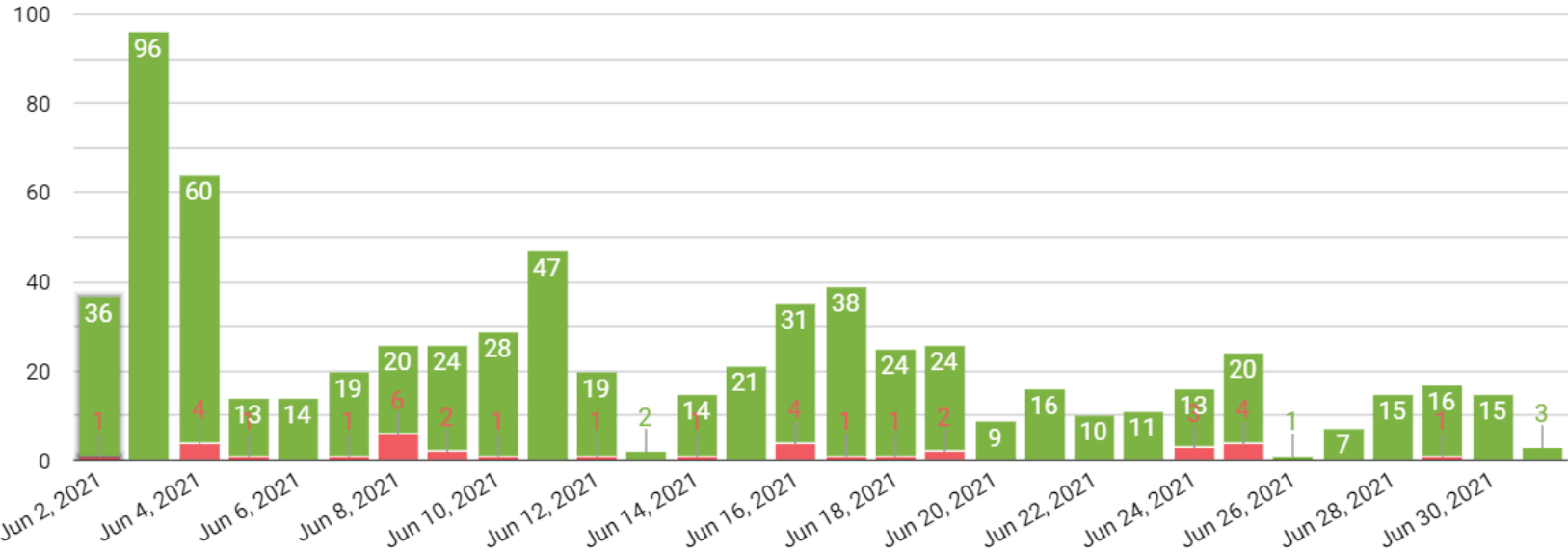

Delta Variant Growth

- ▶ The Delta variant (B.1.617.2) is a mutation of the coronavirus originating in India
- ▶ It has been found to be nearly 2x more transmissible, leading to higher levels of hospitalization
- ▶ The Delta variant is prevalent in the Western Slope
- ▶ Delta Variant has been identified in Gunnison County
 - ▶ So far, 7 Delta cases have been identified locally
- ▶ The best way limit the growth of the Delta variant is vaccination
 - ▶ Studies in the UK show 2 doses of Pfizer as 87% effective against the Delta variant
- ▶ Other ways to limit risk include:
 - ▶ Avoiding large, indoor events with poor ventilation and unvaccinated people
 - ▶ Mask wearing in public places
 - ▶ High levels of hand-washing

Gunnison County Vaccination Progress

- ▶ As of 6/28/21: 10,497 county residents are fully vaccinated
 - ▶ Over 68% of the eligible population (12+) is fully vaccinated
- ▶ Vaccination remains the best protection against variants of the Coronavirus
 - ▶ Two doses have proven to be much more effective against the Delta variant
 - ▶ Overwhelming majority of cases in Gunnison County and throughout Colorado have been among unvaccinated persons

Vaccine Availability

Expiration of the Gunnison County Public Health Order

- ▶ As of 7/1/21 the Gunnison County Public Health Order has expired
 - ▶ There are no remaining, local public health restrictions
 - ▶ We encourage the unvaccinated to continue to wear facial coverings in public
 - ▶ Others may wear masks, especially in public or large gatherings. We encourage everyone to be supportive and considerate of all persons with masks.
- ▶ An [Executive Order](#) remains in effect at the State level with limited requirements for facial coverings in the unvaccinated, in specific contexts
- ▶ Homeless shelters, Prisons/Jails, and Emergency Medical and other Healthcare settings
 - ▶ (including hospitals, ambulatory surgical centers, urgent care centers, clinics, doctors' offices, and non-urgent care medical structures)
- ▶ Federal requirements still call for facial coverings on public transportation

Incident Command

- ▶ After 481 days, the County Incident Command will close all operations effective 7/1/2021
- ▶ Aspects of the response will continue with the County HHS office as well as community health care providers including GVH for testing, vaccinations and disease monitoring, prevention and response
