COVID-19 TRANSMISSION UPDATE

- Throughout the summer Gunnison County was averaging approximately 7-10 total positive tests a week
 - In each of the last two weeks those total positive tests have approximately tripled
- Individual data points are less relevant than trends Gunnison County is continuing to monitor spread in our community to assess for more definitive trends
- With the high volume of people in our community this summer, we see local residents, part-time residents, and visitors testing positive for COVID-19



WHAT NEXT?

- Community level responses to the spread of COVID-19 have been effective for us throughout the pandemic
- What mitigation steps can you support in your own business?
- 1. Get vaccinated and talk with your employees about vaccination
- 2. Consider ventilation. Maximize your effective ventilation. Use outdoor air exchange where possible, HEPA filters, or outdoor opportunities
- 3. Consider facial coverings consistent with CDC guidance
