Pfizer Booster Doses

- ▶ On 9/24/21, the CDC finalized [guidance](#) for the administration of booster doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.
- ▶ Specific groups of people who received a primary, two-dose series of Pfizer vaccine at least six months ago are eligible for a booster shot.



Pfizer Booster Recommendations

SHOULD receive a booster

- ▶ YOU ARE 65 AND OLDER, OR LIVE IN A LONG TERM CARE FACILITY.
- ▶ YOU ARE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 50-64 WITH UNDERLYING MEDICAL CONDITIONS.

MAY receive a booster

- ▶ You are 18-49 with underlying medical conditions based on individual benefit and risk.
- ▶ You are 18-64 and have increased risk for COVID-19 exposure because of occupational setting (Healthcare, Teachers, etc.) based on individual benefit and risk

Key Messages On Pfizer Boosters

- ▶ Boosters currently only approved for recipients of Pfizer
 - ▶ Data being analyzed for other vaccines
- ▶ Must have previously received the Pfizer two-dose series
- ▶ 2nd Dose at least 6 months ago
- ▶ Individuals self-attest to eligibility

Additional Doses for the Immunocompromised

- An additional/3rd dose for either Pfizer or Moderna has an EUA for specific groups of people with *compromised immune systems*
 - If you meet one of these conditions, you can self-attest to receiving a 3rd dose
 - The local pharmacies (Clark's, City Market, and Wal-Mart) all have Moderna
 - You can also schedule a 3rd dose by calling 970-641-3244 and scheduling an appointment
- ▶ Receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
 - ▶ Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - ▶ Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - ▶ Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
 - ▶ Advanced or untreated HIV infection
 - ▶ Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response

9/29/21 - Pfizer Vax Clinic

- ▶ At Fred Field Center from 4:30pm - 6:30pm
 - ▶ Must be in line by 6:30pm
 - ▶ Essential to bring your vaccine card/record of vaccination
 - ▶ There is limited capacity to look up everyone's individual records
 - ▶ Boosters will only be delivered to those with a documented Pfizer series
 - ▶ Must have received 2nd dose at least 6 months ago
 - ▶ The clinic will only have Pfizer vaccine available
 - ▶ Facial covering/mask required at the clinic
